Combi Pipe has a diffusion layer that protects against oxygen penetration through the pipe wall and into the heating system.

Quick & Easy fittings (Q&E) is a type of compression fitting which consists of a coupling housing/nipple made of dezincification-resistant brass or plastic (PPSU/PPS) and the PE-RT ring Evolution (Evo) with stop edge or PE-Xa ring with or without stop edge for compression.

Elbows, tees and nipple/connector housings reducers as set out in Annex I the following ISO dimensions: 12, 16, 20, 25, 32, 40, 50, 63, and 75.

Manifolds and fittings as set out in the Annex

The fittings are manufactured for PEX pipes in ISO dimensions as follows:

Version 1 PE-Xa Q&E ring without stop edge is available in natural, blue and red colours in dimensions:

- Dimension 12x1.7. Note, there is only brass nipple in this dimension.
- Dimensions 16x2.0, 16x2.2, 20x2.8 and 25x3.5 mm and may be used for both brass and plastic nipple/connector housings (PPSU/PPS).
- Dimensions 32x4.4 mm and may be used for both brass and plastic nipple/connector housings (PPSU).
